RED LODGE MOUNTAIN RESORT WILL OFFER TOP-TO-BOTTOM SKIING ON OPENING DAY

Red Lodge, MT – November 23, 2009 – Early snowfall has Red Lodge Mountain Resort prepared for its best opening in a long time. The resort will kick off the season on November 27, and for the first time in 13 years, the Grizzly Peak chair will run on opening day, offering top-to-bottom skiing for Thanksgiving weekend. Three chair lifts plus the magic carpet are slated to run, and at least 33 runs will be available, offering groomed and packed powder conditions. “We’ve got great coverage” says Red Lodge Mountain Resort’s General Manager Jeff Schmidt, “and we’re thrilled to be opening with more terrain than we’ve opened with in many years.”

The resort has also purchased a snow plow from Carbon County in its efforts to open the resort in a timelier manner on big snow days. The plow will be stored at the county’s road shed, allowing the resort to plow from the bottom to the top of the road, as opposed to getting up to the resort first on a snow day and plowing down.
