

2023/24 Uphill Travel Agreement

Access for uphill travel (hiking-to-ski) on Red Lodge Mountain is a privilege, please be respectful of these rules and be safe. Our Uphill Policy is in effect during our operating season (opening day – closing day). Outside of this time-frame, Uphill Travel is not restricted and at-your-own-risk. Red Lodge Mountain may close uphill travel at any time and without warning to ensure safety, security, and order.

UPHILL POLICY

- 1. Uphill Travel permitted between the hours of 4:30pm and 9:00am.
- 2. Uphill Travel Pass or single use tickets are required, and must be worn in an easily visible location.
 - a. Uphill Pass will be included with any purchase of a 2023-24 Season Pass or 6-Tix. All users will need to sign a waiver and obtain their Pass and a reflective armband in person at the Ticket Office.
- 3. For your safety and ours, STEER CLEAR of any runs with snow making equipment. (High-voltage electrical mixed with high-pressure water lines can result in serious injury or death). Do not ski over hoses or power cables.
- 4. ALWAYS check the snow report page on our website prior to heading out. It will have pertinent information regarding avalanche control work &/or closures. Watch for the flashing red light on the left side of the entrance gate, which indicates when uphill travel is prohibited.
- 5. STAY ALERT to what's going on around you, especially equipment, machinery, other skiers & riders. Move out of the way of snow cats and snowmobiles.
- 6. LIMIT your uphill travel, to no more than 2 people abreast.
- 7. LEAVE your dogs at home. Unfortunately, a few irresponsible dog owners have forced us to make this rule.
- 8. PLAN AHEAD and know that conditions change quickly. Temps can be sub-zero, especially with wind, and will get colder when the sun goes down.
- 9. Uphill Travel is BACKCOUNTRY SKIING. There are many unmarked hazards. The area is not patrolled. Avalanche danger exists. If you need rescuing, call 911.
- 10. BE SEEN and wear reflective clothing, especially in poor lighting.
- 11. NEVER GO ALONE.

ROUTES

- There are two required uphill routes:
 - on lookers left: Show Off Alley to Chicken Trail to Lazy M to Grizzly Peak Summit
 - beginning on lookers left: Show Off Alley to Otto Bahn. As Otto Bahn passes Ladies Aid, move to lookers right and continue from Otto Bahn to Turnpike to Midway Chalet.
- All travel PROHIBITED on:
 - o closed trails
 - o any run on which snow making equipment is present.
 - all terrain park features
 - the following routes due to potential winch cat grooming: Pine Ridge, Upper Limited, Lower Limited, Big Silver, Little Tree,
 Face of M, Upper Royals, Drifter, Latigo

TERMS & CONDITIONS

The following outlines Red Lodge Mountain's Uphill Pass/Ticket Policies. By purchasing an Uphill Pass/Ticket the Pass Holder agrees to these terms and conditions, and agrees to abide by the policies of Red Lodge Grizzly Peak, Inc. The terms "Pass" and "Passes" refer to Uphill Passes and Uphill Tickets. The term "Pass Holder" refers to purchasers of an Uphill Pass or Uphill Ticket.

- 1. A Red Lodge Mountain (RLM) Uphill Pass is **NOT REFUNDABLE** due to snow conditions, the Pass Holder's physical condition, injury, pregnancy, change of residence, or for any other reason.
- 2. Pass privileges are **NOT TRANSFERABLE** (to another person and/or date) and may not be used by anyone other than the Pass Holder. **Use of these passes by anyone other than the person to whom the card is issued is a criminal offense.** This misuse is considered "Theft of Services" under Section 45-6-305, MCA, 1978, and carries a fine up to \$500 and/or imprisonment up to six months.
- 3. Rollovers of Uphill Passes to the next season are not permitted for any reason
- 4. Pass Holder agrees to carry his/her Pass whenever uphilling, and to present the pass to resort personnel for inspection if requested.
- 5. Passes that are lost, stolen, broken, damaged or otherwise abused and fail to function must be replaced for a fee of \$15.00.
- 6. Resort operating times and dates are at the sole discretion of Red Lodge Mountain and are subject to change at any time and

without notice and without refund or compensation. We may at times close uphill travel at the resort to ensure safety, security and order, or if we consider that circumstances so require.

7. Red Lodge Mountain Management reserves the right to revoke the Pass and its privileges at any time and for any reason.

ASSUMPTION OF RISKS

I acknowledge that skiing, snowboarding and all type of activities involving sliding or jumping on snow or ice involves inherent threats and dangers that are part of the sport and cannot be eliminated. These inherent threats and dangers include, but are not limited to; changing weather conditions, snow conditions as they exist or as they may change, including ice, hardpack, powder, packed powder, windpack, corn snow, crust, slush, machine made snow, and avalanches (except on open, designated ski trails); collisions with natural surface or subsurface conditions, such as, but not limited to, bare spots, forest growth, rocks, stumps, streambeds, cliffs, trees, and other natural objects; collisions with lift towers, signs, posts, fences, enclosures, hydrants, water pipes, or other artificial structures and their components; variations in steepness and terrain, whether natural or the result of slope design, snowmaking, or snow grooming operations, including, but not limited to, roads, freestyle terrain, ski jumps, catwalks, and other terrain modifications; collisions with clearly visible or plainly marked equipment, including, but not limited to lift equipment, snowmaking equipment, snow grooming equipment, trail maintenance equipment and snowmobiles, whether or not the equipment is moving; collisions with other skiers; the failure of a skier to ski within that skier's ability; skiing in a closed area or skiing outside the ski area boundary as designated on the ski area trail map; and restricted visibility caused by snow, wind, fog, sun, darkness, or other atmospheric conditions. I accept all legal responsibility for injury or damage of any kind to the extent that the injury or damage results from inherent dangers and risks of skiing, snowboarding and the activities listed above.

I hereby waive any right that I may have to monetary compensation, royalties or other consideration and agree that no additional remuneration, financial or otherwise will be transacted.
